# WHERE ARE WE?

- **Campinas Metropolitan Region (RMC)**
  - 19 municipalities (2.8 million inhabitants)
  - GDP = US\$ 50.3 billion (2010)
    - approx . 3% Brazil's GDP
    - 7.8% São Paulo State's GDP
  - 6% of Brazil's industrial production (3<sup>rd</sup> largest industrial region)
  - 50 of the 500 world's largest companies have branches in Campinas region: Motorola, IBM, HP, 3M, Honda, Goodyear, Samsung, Erickson, Compaq, Syngenta...

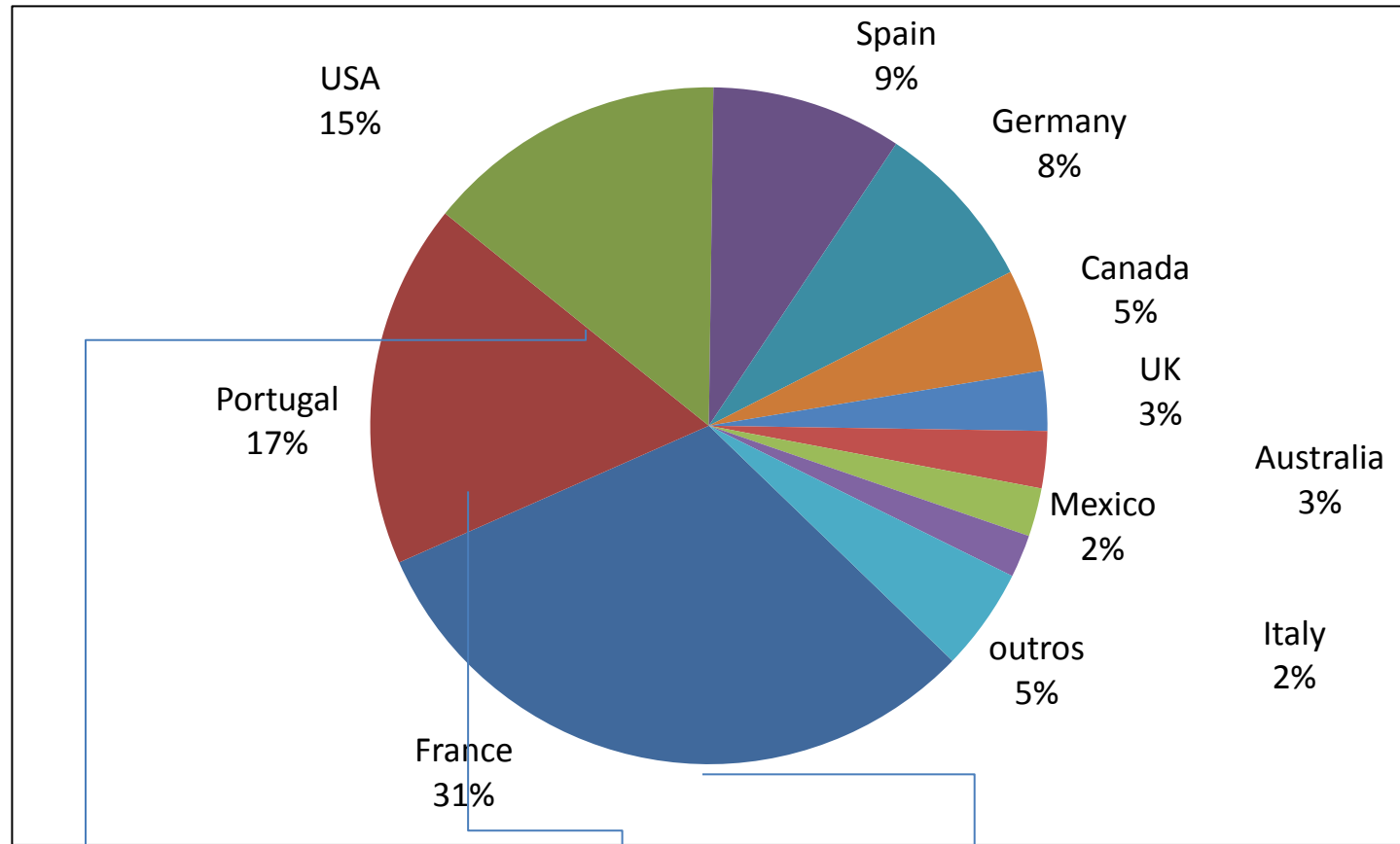

# FOREIGN STUDENTS AT UNICAMP



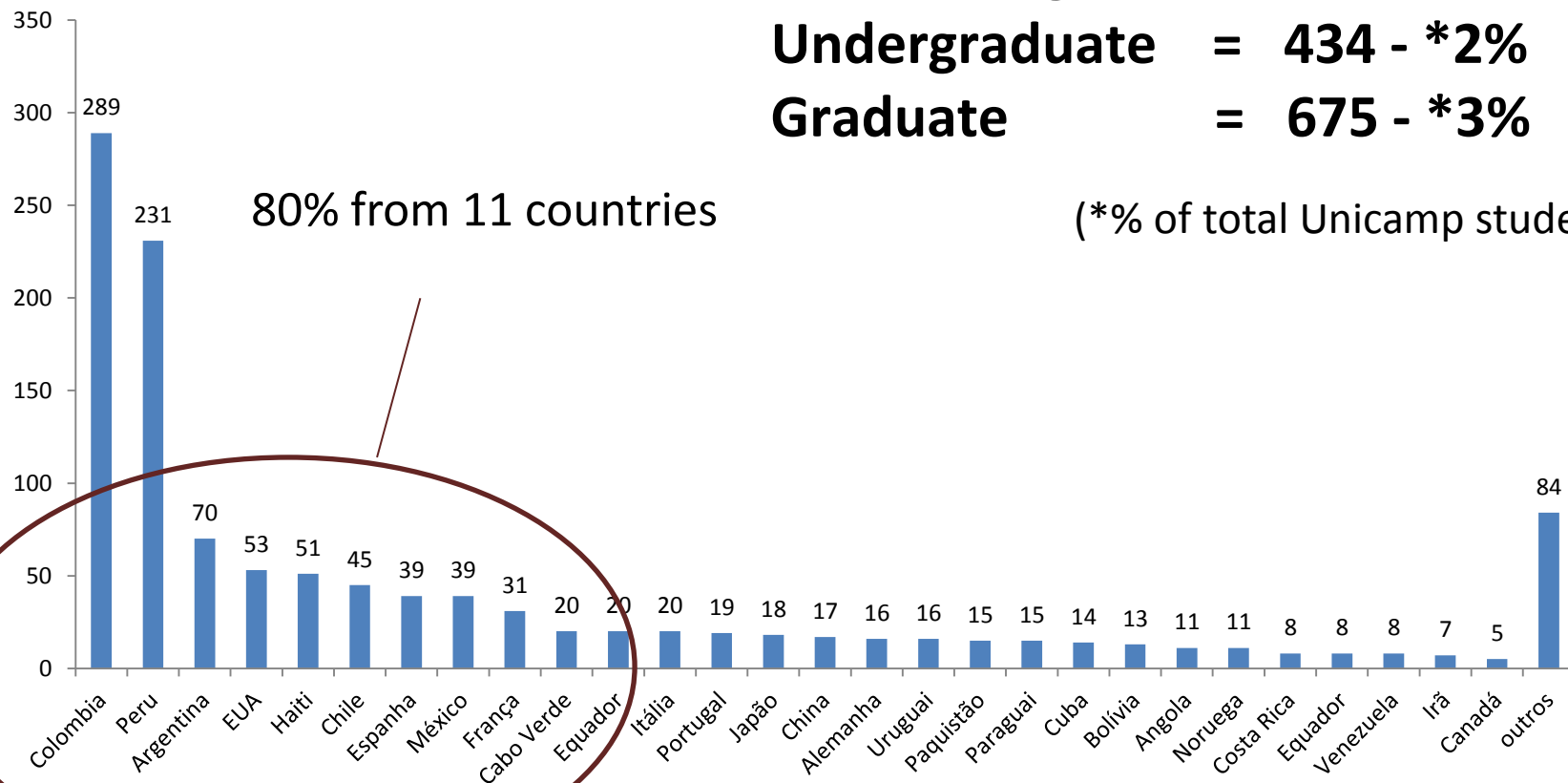
# FOREIGN STUDENTS AT UNICAMP

## Celpe-Bras – Portuguese Proficiency Certificate for Foreigners

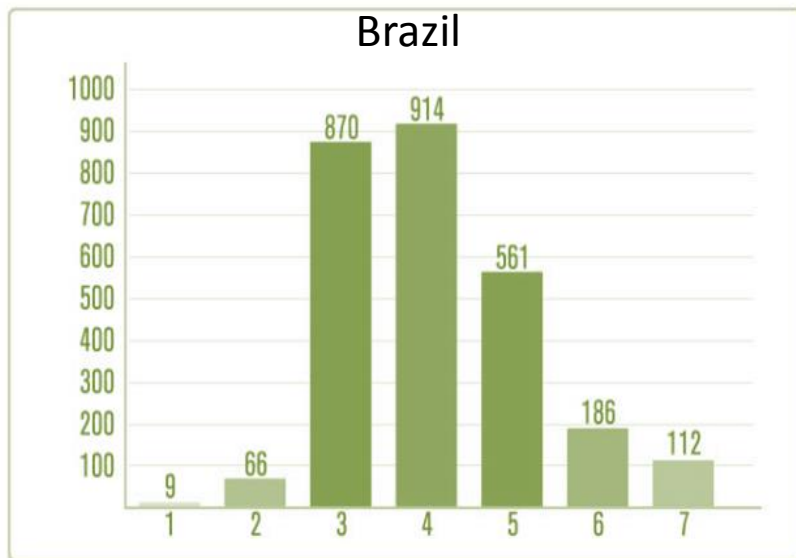
It is applied in Brazil with the support of Ministry of Foreign Affairs

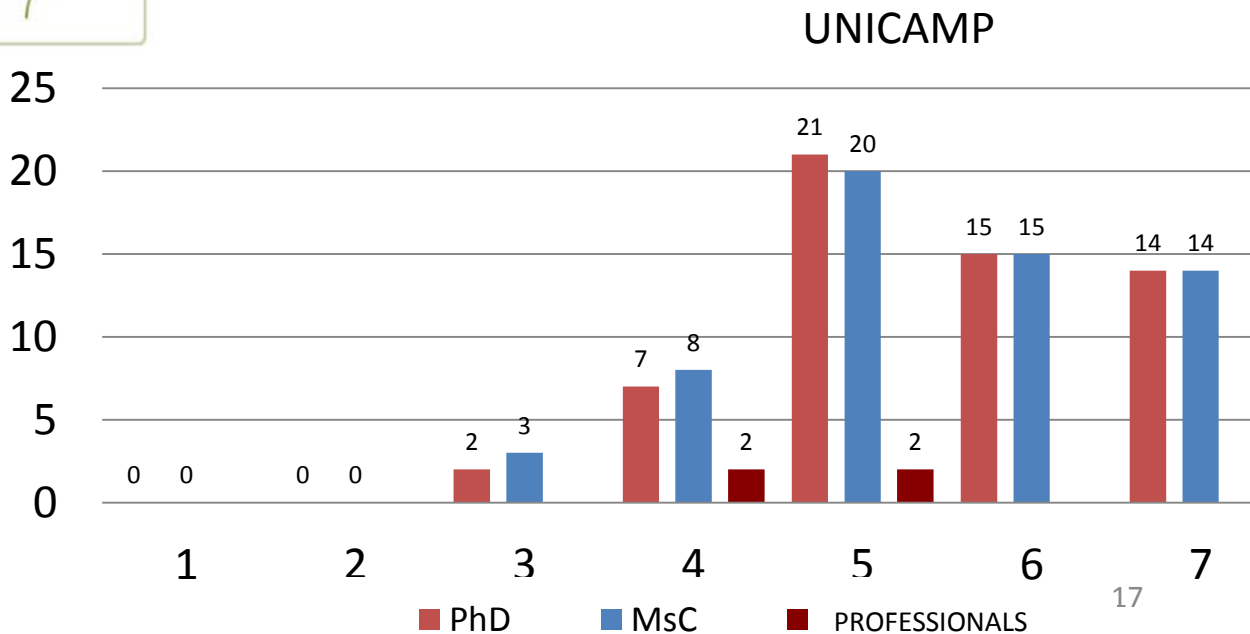
# CAPES ASSESSMENT – 2010 (triennial - scale 1 – 7)

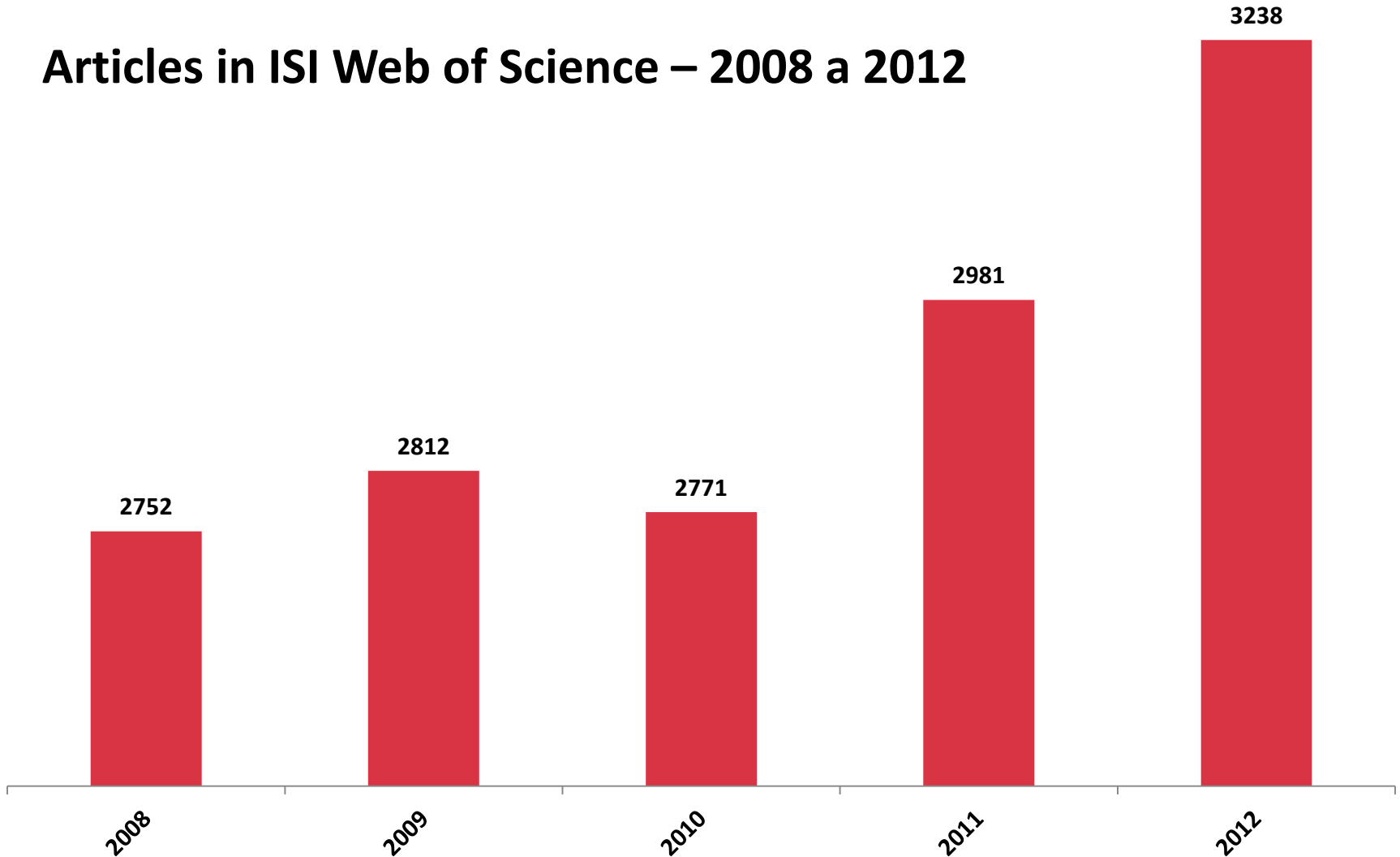

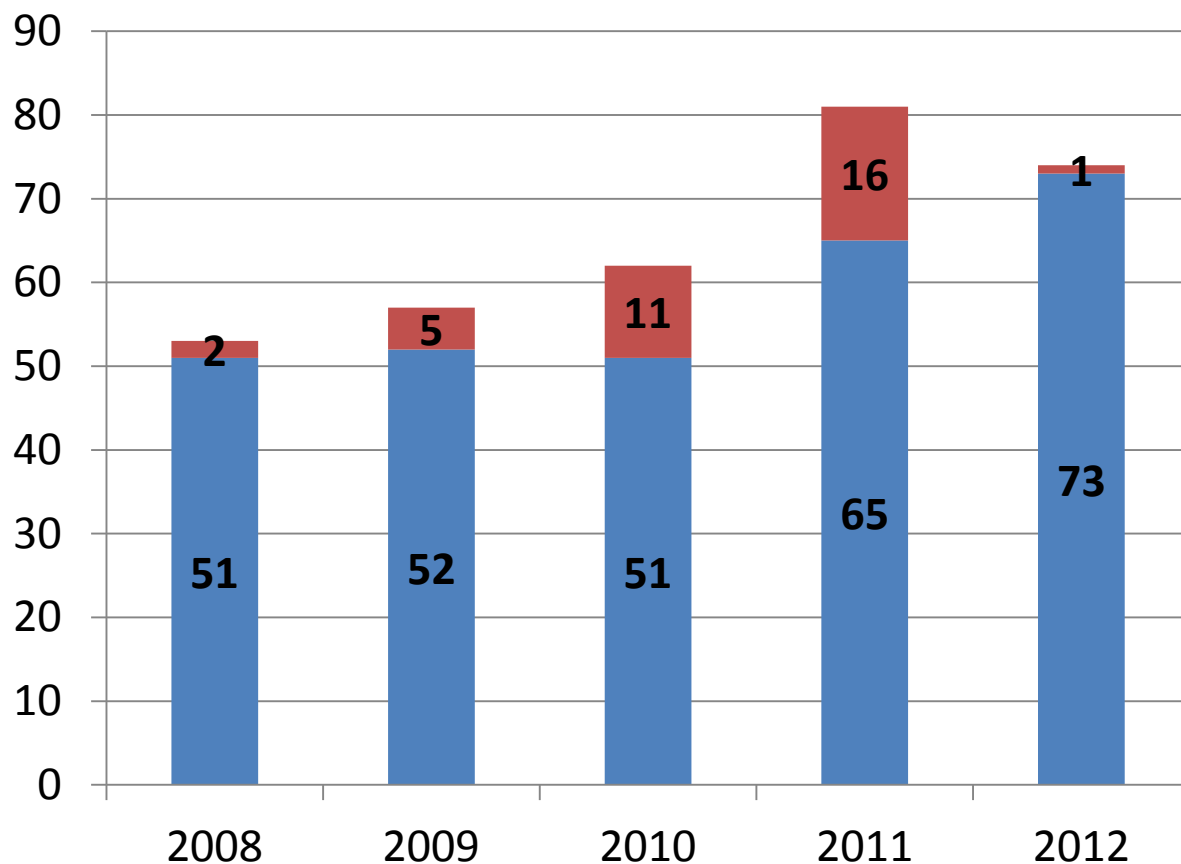

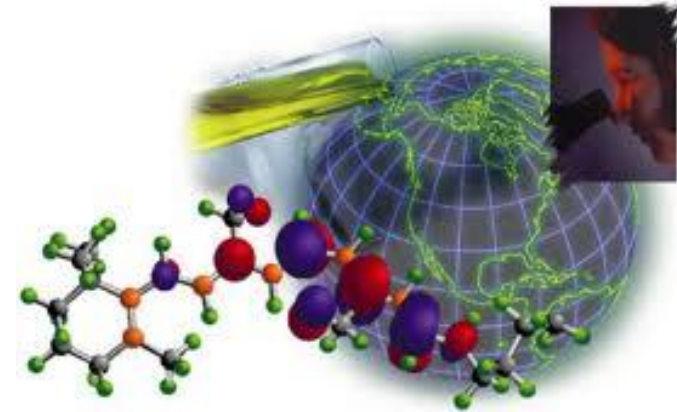
